- 108 — 1m. brown with overprint double, one albino in an imperforate block of twelve (2x6), with selvage showing plate number “3”, and with printers handstamp “7 JAN 1908” in blue, two lightly creased and some minor soiling, otherwise a fresh and dramatic item. E.S.C. certificate (1979) £300-400

- 109 — 1pi. blue a complete sheet of two hundred and forty (20x12, arranged in four panes of sixty), one with variety “broken O” [position 116], and selvage showing plate number “4” in four positions, light diagonal crease affecting two panes, folded along perforations and some perfs split etc. but generally in very fine condition for such a multiple. £80-100
- 110 — 5pi. slate-grey in a complete sheet of two hundred and forty (20x12, similar format to last), showing “broken O” variety and with marginal plate number “2” in four places, some minor wrinkles, a few perfs split and selvage faults, but mostly very fine and fresh. £650-700
- 111 **1913 O.H.H.S.:** 5m. rose mint with plate number blocks from plates “5” (6x6), and four blocks from plate “6”, used includes one with inverted overprint, and a study of overprint varieties, etc. (390±) £60-80
- 112 **1914 Definitives:** 10m. dull blue with inverted watermark, a complete unmounted mint pane of one hundred (10x10) showing marginal plate number “2”, one or two rust spots on reverse otherwise fine and rare. (vendor states “only one sheet known to exist”). Balian 120b, unpriced. £300-350
- 113 — 10m. irregular block of forty-eight, also block of four and a vertical strip of five, several rust spots and five with pencil mark on reverse, good to fine. (57) £100-120
