

KING FAROUK First Definitive Issue



30 November 1941

Airmail cover from Cairo to Wayville South Australia.

RATE: 17 mills foreign rate plus 30 mills airmail for half ounce. Total 47 mills

Censorship. Small round Egyptian Censorship Dept. handstamp and Australian Censor tape and handstamp.

19 May 1942

Cover from Sidi Gaber to Wayville South Australia.

RATE: 17 mills per half ounce by sea mail.

Bears Egyptian Postal Censor handstamp and Censorship tape.



KING FAROUK First Definitive Issue

2 December 1944



Two very similar airmail covers from Cairo to Rotheram, England. The upper cover bears the first of the new design King Farouk stamps, used two weeks after its release.

21 December 1944



RATE: 17 mills foreign rate plus 30 mills airmail per half ounce.

Both items bear two British Censor handstamps applied in Cairo.

21 December 1945

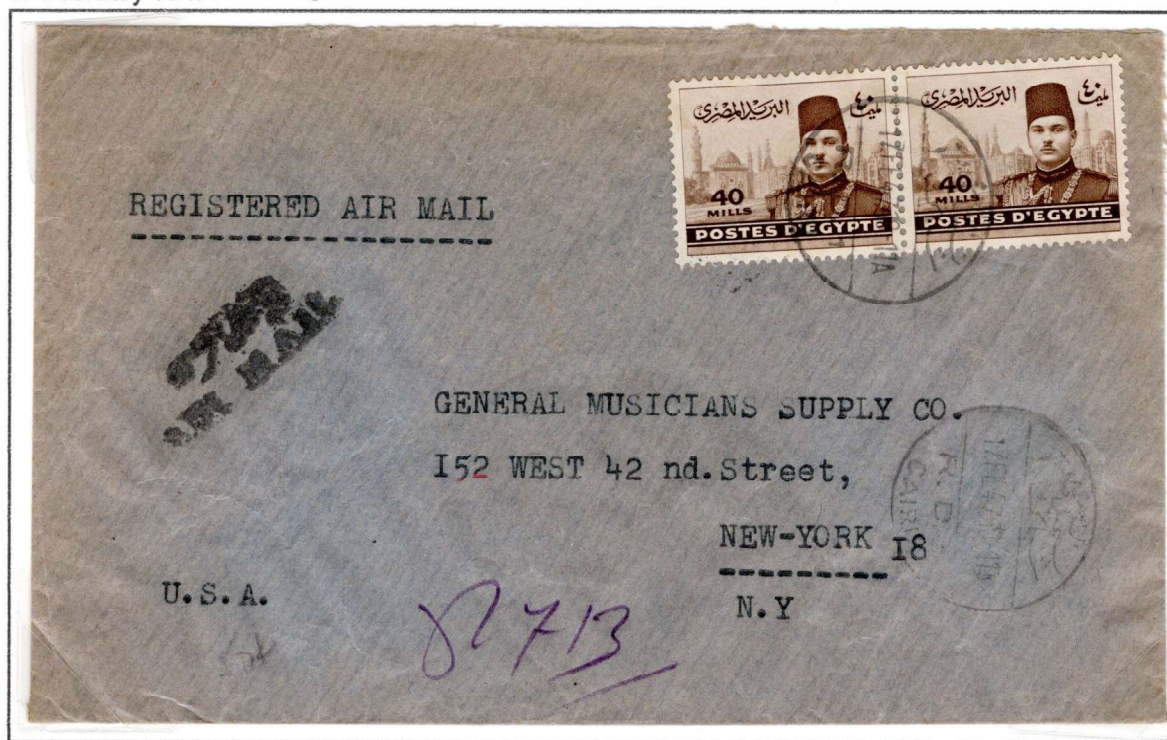
Airmail cover from Cairo to London, England.



Rate: 10 gms; Domestic 4 mills, Airmail 30 mills = Total 34 mills. mil.

17 February 1947

Registered Airmail cover from Cairo to New York, U.S.A.



Rate: 10 gms; Letter rate 22 mills, Airmail 25 mills, Registration 32 mills = Total 79 mills. (1 mil overpaid)

KING FAROUK Third Definitive Issue

1946 & 1947: Foreign rate covers by surface mail.

1946

Cover from Cairo to Vienna, Austria.

Opened and resealed with Austrian Censor handstamp.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms.



3 June 1947

Cover from Cairo to Wisconsin, U.S.A.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms.

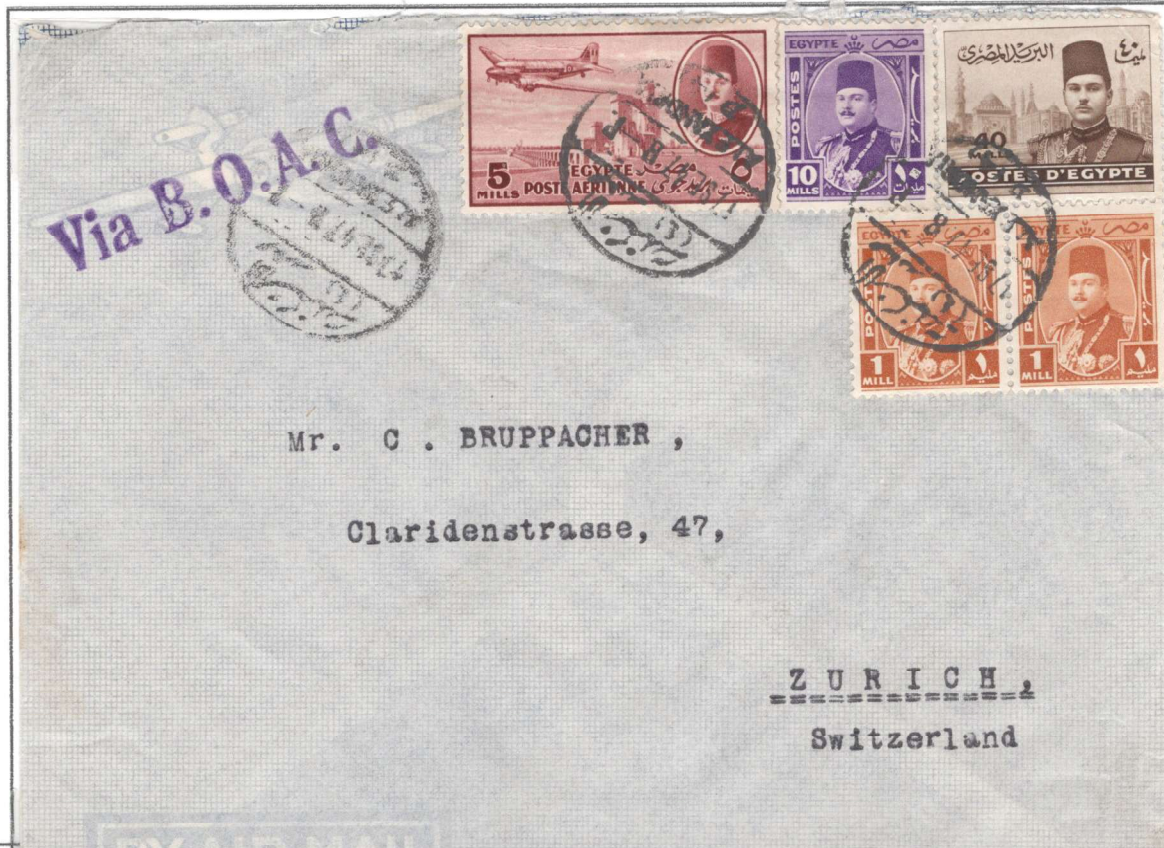
KING FAROUK Airmail Issue

Airmail covers to Switzerland.

17 September 1947.

Cover from Alexandria to Zurich, Switzerland.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 35 mills for 5 gms airmail to Switzerland via B.O.A.C. Total: 57 mills.



12 November 1947.

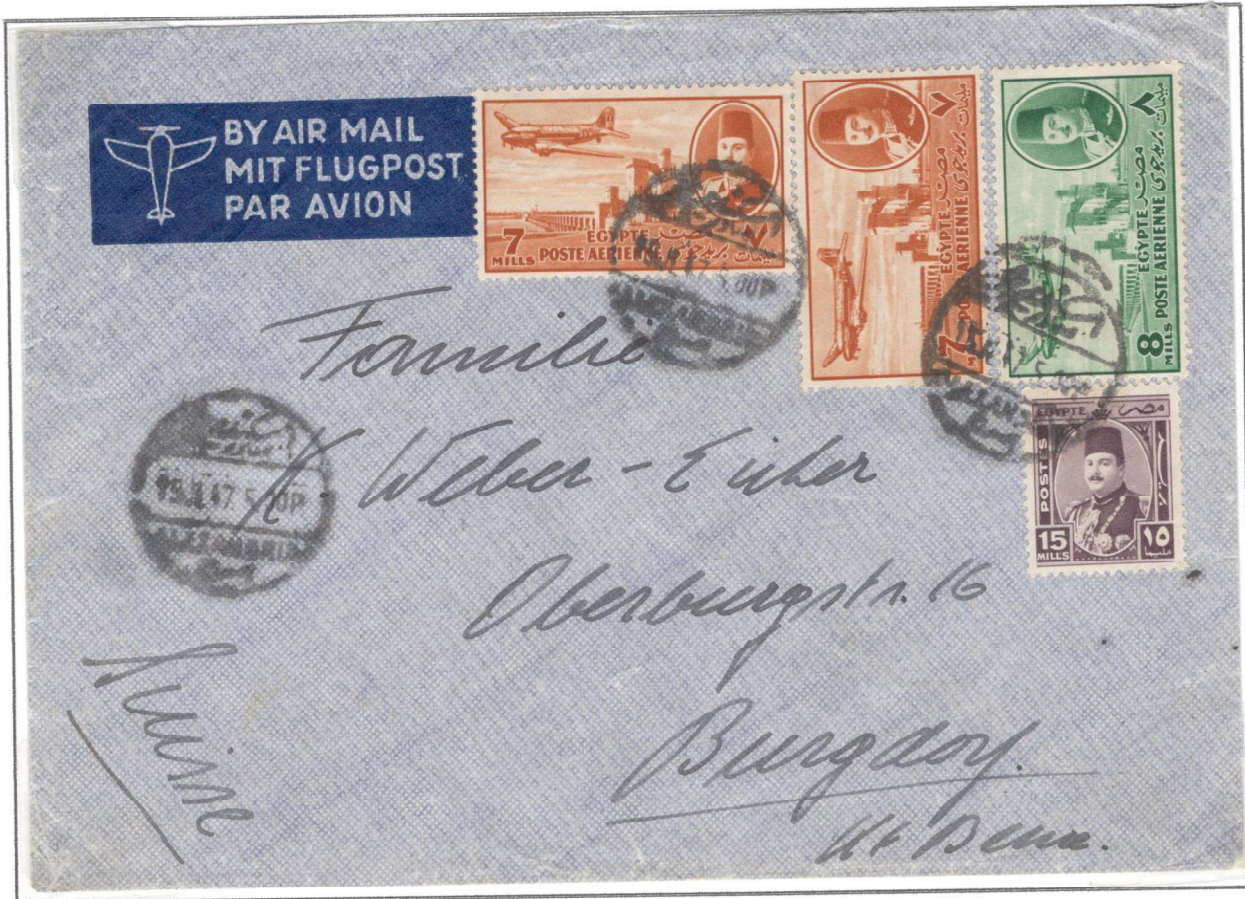
Cover from Alexandria to Burgdorf.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 15 mills for 5 gms airmail via T.W.A. Total 37 mills.

NOTE: T.W.A. reduced their airmail rates in Europe in March 1947. B.O.A.C. did not reduce their rates until August 1948.

1947 & 1949: Airmail covers to Europe.



15 November 1947.

Cover from Alexandria to Burgdorf, Switzerland.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 15 mills for 5 gms airmail. Total 37 Mills.

30 March 1949.

Cover from Alexandria ? to British sector, Berlin, Germany.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 15 mills for 5 gms airmail. Total 37 mills.



KING FAROUK Third Definitive Issue and Airmail stamps.

1948 1951: Air mail covers to Brazil.

29 January 1948

Airmail cover from Cairo
to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

RATE: 22 mills foreign
rate plus 55 mills
airmail probably for
10 gms.
TOTAL 77 mills.



27 October 1951

Airmail cover from Cairo
to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

Probably carried by
BOAC to London.

RATE: 22 mills foreign
rate plus 60 mills
airmail for 10gms.
TOTAL 82 mills.

KING FAROUK Airmail Issue

1948 & 1950: Airmail covers to New Zealand and Australia.



21 August 1948.

Cover from Cairo to Wellington, New Zealand

RATE: 17 mills Empire rate for 10 gms plus 55 mills for 5 gms airmail. Total 72 mills.

4 February 1950.

Cover from Alexandria to Sydney, Australia.

RATE: 17mills Empire rate for 10 gms plus 55 millls for 5 gms airmail. Total 72 mills. Overpaid 1 mill.

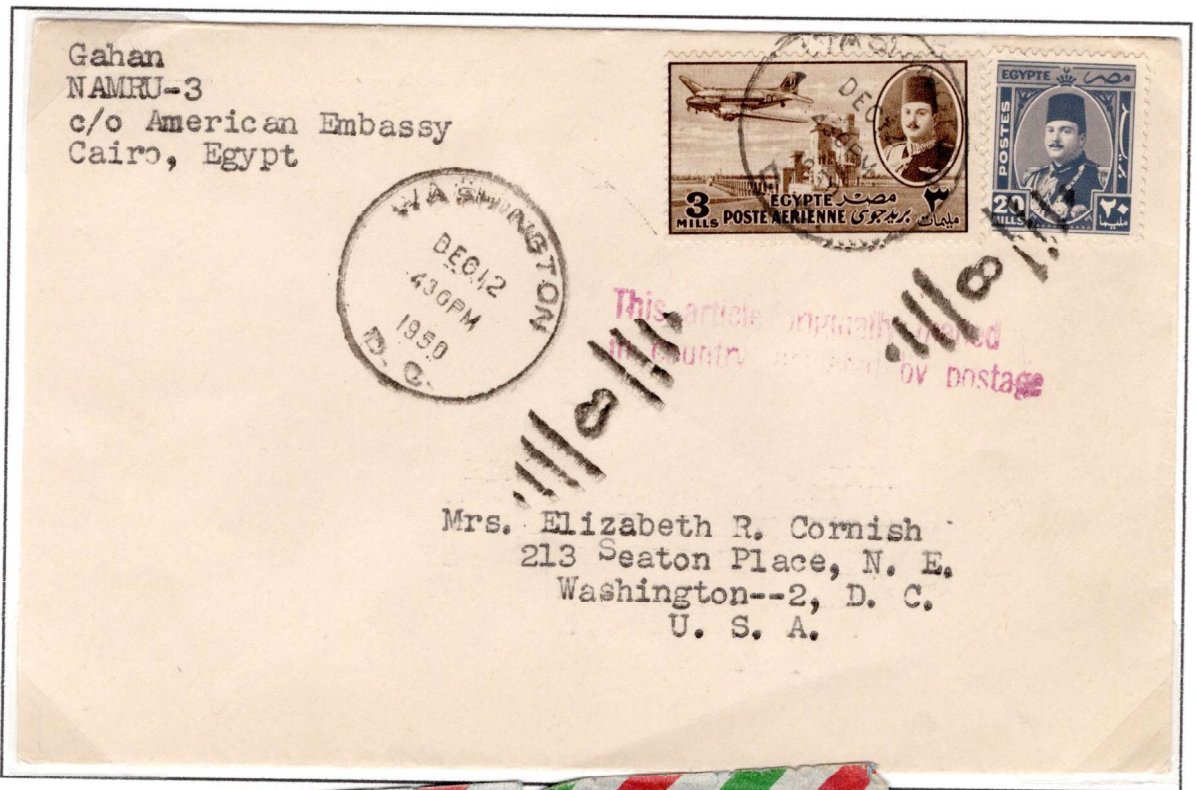


KING FAROUK First Airmail Issue

December 1950.

Cover from Cairo to Washington carried in a diplomatic mail. Stamps not necessary.

Handstamp
 "This article originated in the country indicated by postage."
 would have been applied in U.S.A.



10 April 1951: Cover from Cairo to U.S.A.

RATE: 32 mills over-seas rate plus 30 mills for 10 gms airmail. Total 62 mills.

KING FAROUK Airmail Issue

Airmail covers to Germany and Britain.

11 April 1951.

Cover from Cairo to St. Georges-Schwarzwald, Germany.

RATE: 32 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 15 mills for 10 gms airmail to Germany.



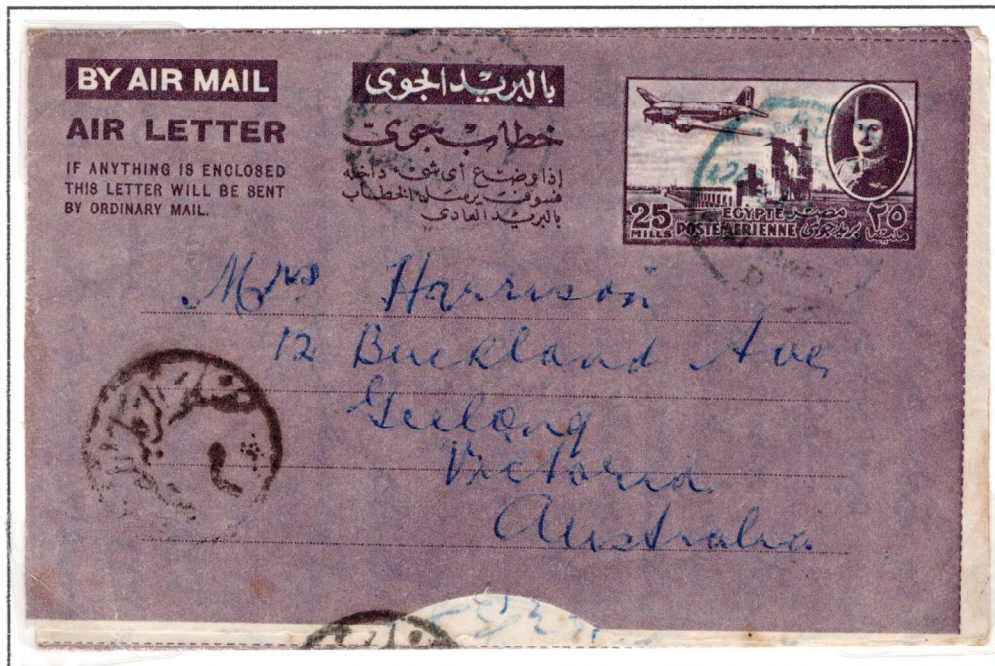
March 1950.

RATE: 17 mills UK concession rate plus 10 mills for 10 gms airmail via B.O.A.C. Total 27 mills.

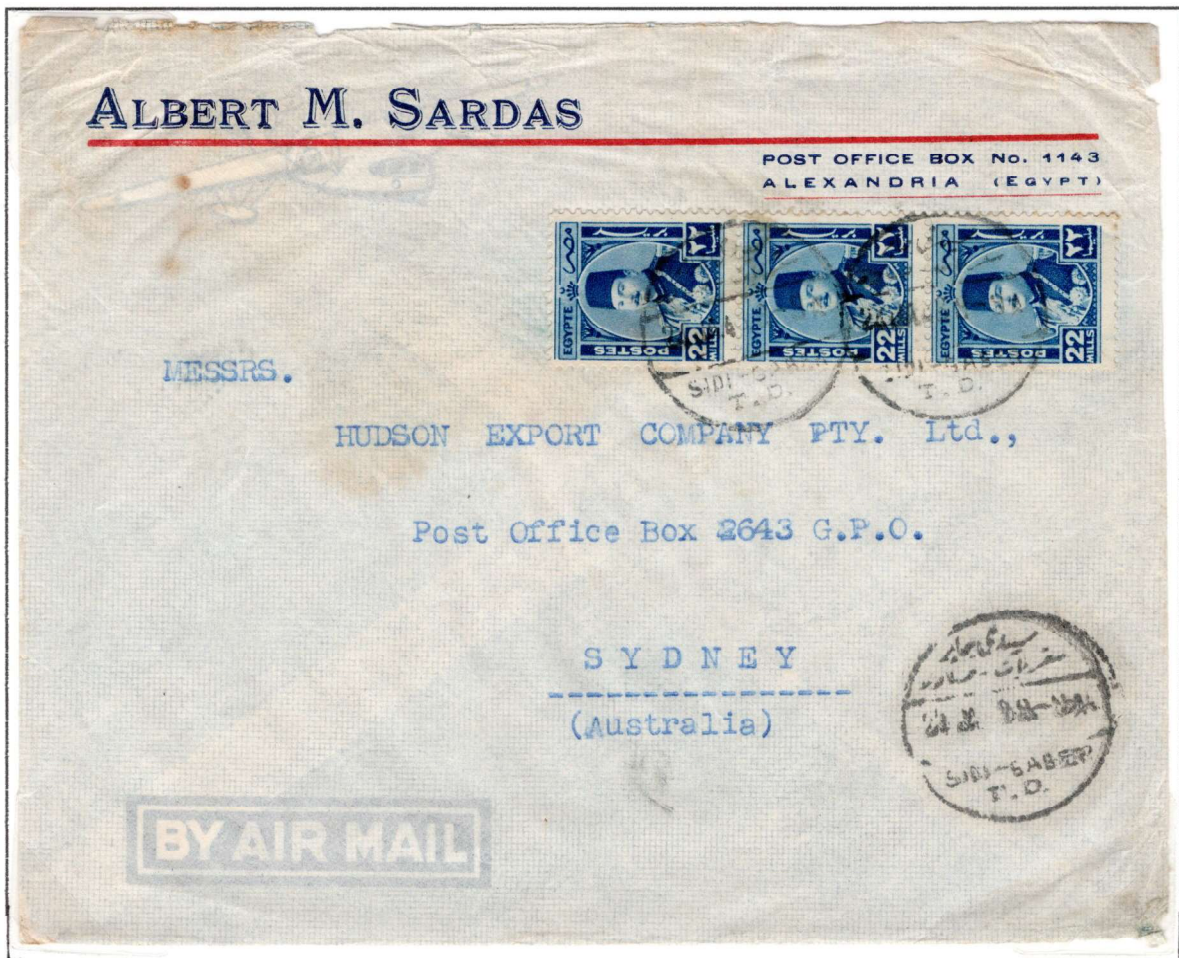
Two covers to Australia.

22 December 1948: 25 mills airmailer from Suez to Geelong, Victoria.



24 February 1948: Air mail letter to Sydney, Australia.

RATE: 17 mills empire concession rate plus 45 mills for 10 gms airmail. Total 62 mills, overpaid 4 mills.



KING FAROUK Third Definitive Issue and Airmail stamps.

1946 1947: Air mail covers to U.S.A.

27 January 1946

Airmail cover from Port Said to Chicago, U.S.A.

Probably carried by BOAC to London.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate plus 40 mills airmail for 5gms. TOTAL 62 mills.



17 July 1947

Airmail cover from Cairo to Milwaukee, U.S.A.

Probably carried by T.W.A.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate plus 25 mills airmail for 5gms. TOTAL 47 mills.

KING FAROUK Third Definitive Issue

22 October 1948: Air mail postcard to Copenhagen, Denmark.
 RATE: Sent at letter rate 22 mils overseas rate plus 20 mils airmail. Total 42 mils.



5 March 1951: Air mail letter to Copenhagen, Denmark.
 RATE: 32 mils overseas rate plus 20 mils airmail. Total 52 mils.



KING FAROUK Third Definitive Issue

16 August 1949: Registered cover from Ibrahimia Ramles to Alexandria

RATE: 10 mills internal rate for 20 gms plus 20 mills for registration.

Total 30 mills.



20 May 1950.

Cover from Alexandria to New Jersey, USA.

RATE: 32 mills foreign rate for 20 gms. Plus 30 mills for 20 gms airmail.

KING FAROUK Third definitive issue

1949 & 1951: Airmail covers to Greece.



29 December 1951.

Cover from Cairo to Athens, Greece.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 15 mills for 5 gms airmail. Total: 37 mills.

19 October 1949.

Cover from Cairo to Athens, Greece..

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 5 mills for 5 gms airmail, special rate to Greece. Plus 32 mills registration fee. Total 59 mills. 1 mill overpaid.

KING FAROUK Third Definitive Issue

Double and single rate covers by Airmail to Europe

26 November 1950.

Cover from Cairo to Milan, Italy.

RATE: 22 mills foreign rate for 20 gms plus 20 mills for 20 gms airmail.

Total 42 mills.



5 May 1952

Cover from Cairo to Uzwil, Switzerland.

RATE: 32 mills foreign rate for 20 gms. (Increased in October 1951) plus 10 mills for 10 gms airmail.

KING FAROUK Third & Fourth Definitive Issues

1951: Air mail covers to Germany

? July 1951.

Airmail cover from Alexandria to Mannheim, Germany.

Probably carried by B.O.A.C.

RATE: 32 mills foreign rate plus 15 mills airmail for 10 gms. TOTAL 37 gms.



Cover carried on same route and destination at same rate made up with different stamps.

1952 two airmail covers to Britain.



21 October 1952



UPPER COVER

Rate: 32 mills letter rate plus 20 mills airmail for 10 gms plus 45 mills airmail = Total 97 mills. There is no indication that the cover was actually registered.

LOWER COVER

Rate: 17 mills Empire rate plus 10 mills for 10 grams airmail.

KING FAROUK With Portrait obliterated.

26 December 1954.

Paquebot cover posted at Port Said to Warrington, England.

RATE: 37 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 15 mills for 10 gms airmail.

Total: 52 mills.



23 January 1954.

Cover from Cairo to Rockdale, N.S.W. Australia..

RATE: 37 mills foreign rate for 10 gms plus 85 mills for 10 gms airmail.
Total: 122 mills.

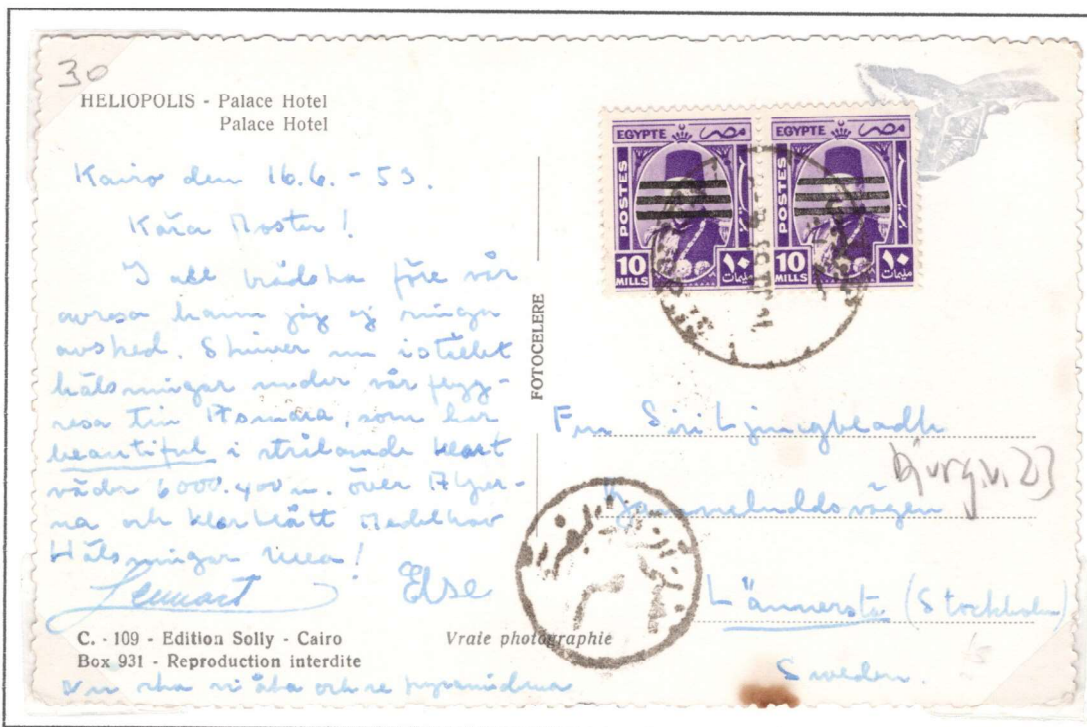

OVERPRINTED PALESTINE FOR USE IN GAZA



13 October 1955 Airmail cover from Gaza to Pennsylvania, USA.

RATE: 37 mills foreign rate for 20 gms. Plus 45 mills for 10 gms airmail. Total 82 mills.

Airmail stamps overprinted King of Egypt and Sudan in Arabic and with King's portrait obliterated.
