

DAMIETTE-TANTA, Type TPO 8A1b, 16 DE 82, to Cairo



AMB. ALEXANDRIE-CAIRE, Type TPO 3B1, used to cancel postage due stamps during the sorting of foreign mails arrived by ship at Alexandria, 6 DE 98



AMBULANT / SUEZ , Type TPO 2A2, 30 JU 91, as transit mark on a post card from Austria to German East Africa. Landed at Port Said (transit mark on back, 29 VII 91), carried by train to Suez, and sent from there by French steamer to Zanzibar (Marseille a la Reunion transit mark, 8 AOUT 91, on back) for trans-shipment.



KAFR EL SHEIKH-SIDI SALEM & V. V.. Type TPO 7A3.5, 4 NO 31, on a registered letter to Al Azhar / Cairo.



AMB! BAHR CHIBIN, Type TPO 3A2, 1 XII 89, to Minet el Bassal/Alexandria, carried by canal steamer to Shibin el Kom (transit strike on reverse), where it was transferred to the train.



M. KAMH-ABOU HAMMAD AMB^t, Type TPO 3A1, 9 IX 08, cancelling stamps on a post card to Budapest, showing transit strikes of CAIRO-MANSURA, PORT SAID-CAIRO and CAIRO-LEXANDRIA TPO's and Bilbeis and Zaqaziq (on back) post offices, all on the same day.



CHALLAL-WADI HALFA, Type TPO 8A7, 6 X 91: Upper Nile steamer route. Addressed to Alexandria, and struck on back at Assuan, 8 OC 91.



Letter from the Egyptian consular post office at CHIOS (SCIO), 4 NOV 76, to the Egyptian post office at Constantinople, bearing a transit strike on the same day of the maritime post office (UFFIZIO NATANTE / ALES) on the Alexandria-Constantinople steamship route.



Registered letter posted on the Z & W TPO, 7 FE 16, on the Western Desert military train route, to England via Base Army Post Office at Alexandria.
