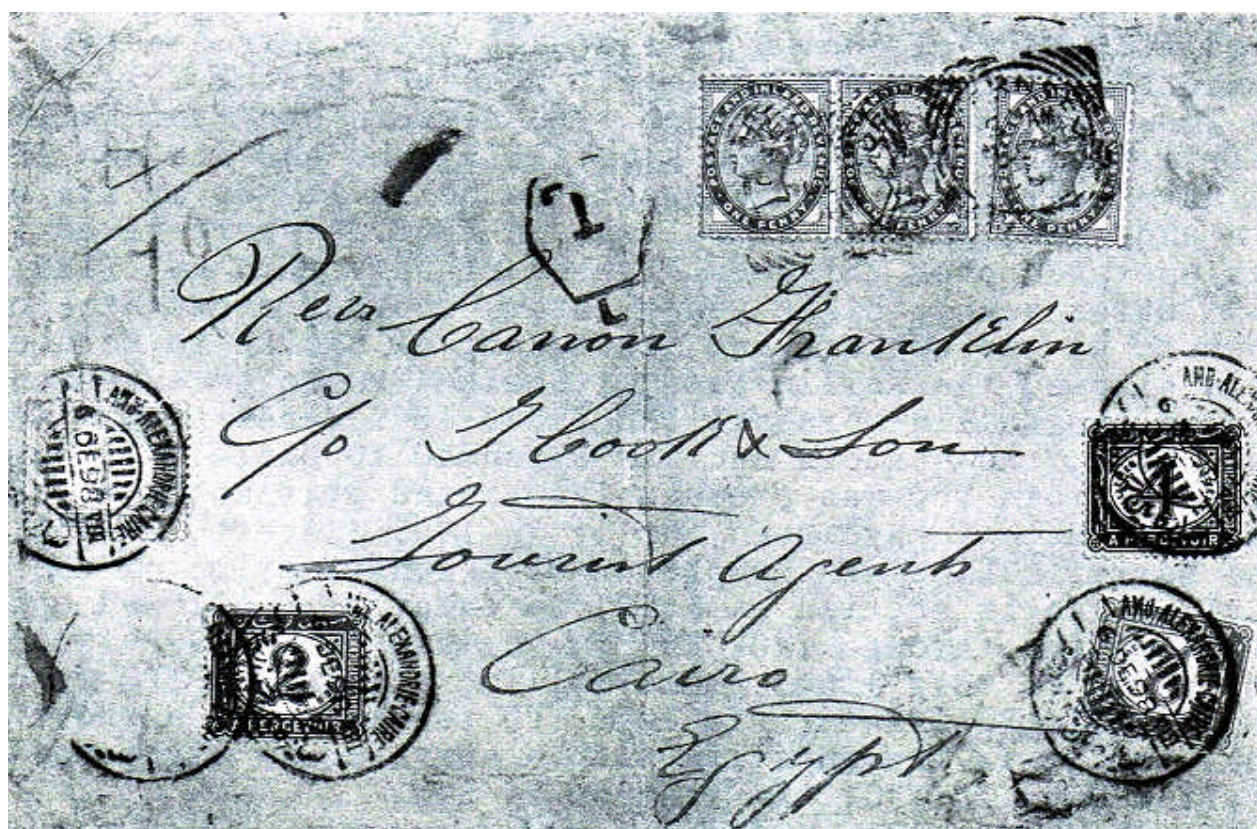


DAMIETTE-TANTA, Type TPO 8A1b, 16 DE 82, to Cairo



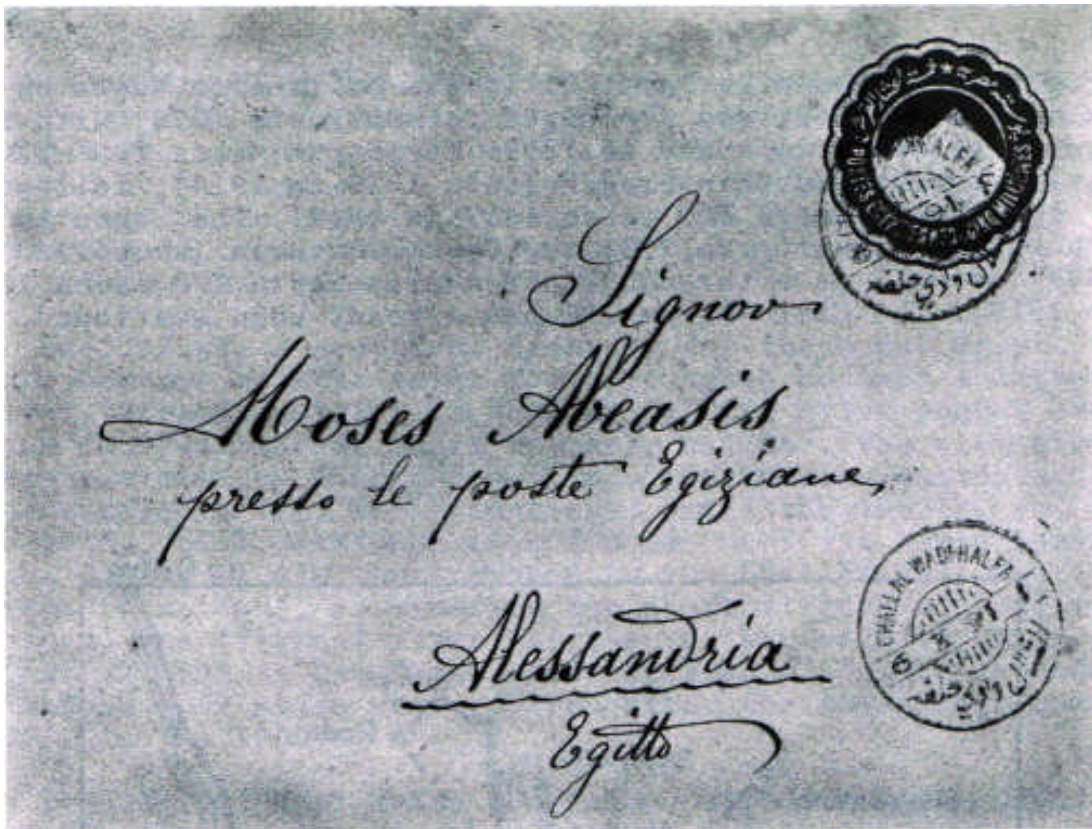

AMB¹ BAHR CHIBIN, Type TPO 3A2, 1 XII 89, to Minet el Bassal/Alexandria, carried by canal steamer to Shibin el Kom (transit strike on reverse), where it was transferred to the train.



M. KAMH-ABOU HAMMAD AMB¹, Type TPO 3A1, 9 IX 08, cancelling stamps on a post card to Budapest, showing transit strikes of CAIRO-MANSOURA, PORT SAID-CAIRO and CAIRO-LEXANDRIA TPO's and Bilbeis and Zaqaqiq (on back) post offices, all on the same day.



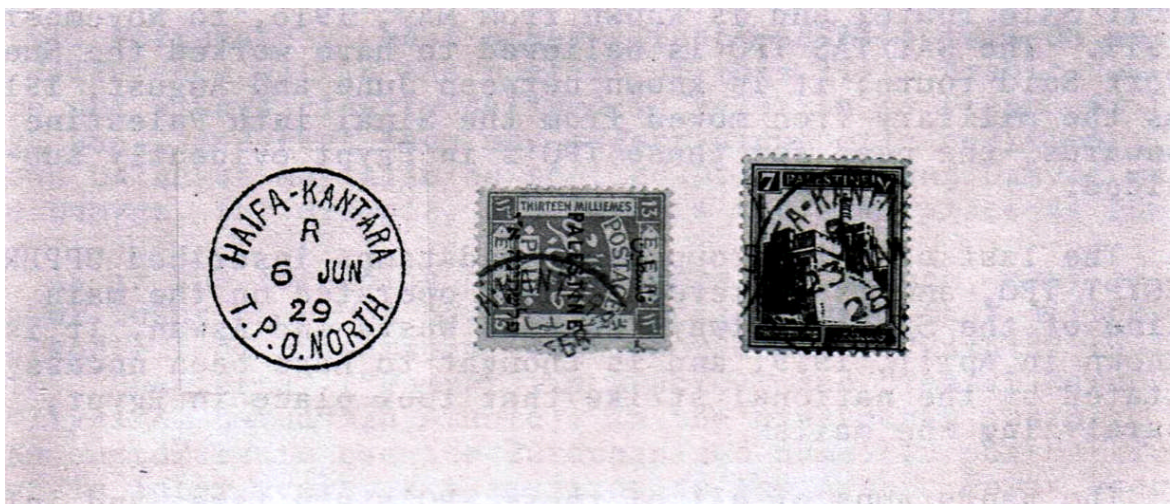
CHALLAL-WADI HALFA, Type TPO 8A7, 6 X 91: Upper Nile steamer route. Addressed to Alexandria, and struck on back at Assuan, 8 OC 91.



Letter from the Egyptian consular post office at CHIOS (SCIO), 4 NOV 76, to the Egyptian post office at Constantinople, bearing a transit strike on the same day of the maritime post office (UFFIZIO NATANTE / ALES) on the Alexandria-Constantinople steamship route.
