PREFACE.

In the following "Classification of the contents of Volumes I & II of the Quarterly Circular "references are given under three main headings

and it is hoped that the following Notes will enable readers to trace any Item of information which they seek.

1. Chapters of the Book.

As at present planned, the Circle's proposed book- "Egypt: Its Stamps and Postal History" - will be found to comprise almost every phase of Egyptian philately and, in these circumstances, every article which is capable of being assigned to any of the chapters of this book will be found under the relevant chapter.

2. The Studies of the Circle.

This heading is intended for Interim Reports on the Studies, Progress Reports and also for all articles and Notes when such have been contributed By a members in charge of such Studies. These articles will also be found under heading I. "Chapters of the Book"

It will be remembered that, in the proposed book, Postal Markings are separated into three periods but in the present classification all articles on the markings will be found under Study IV, "The Postal Markings of Egypt from 1866 to the present day"

3. Miscellaneous.

Under this heading will be found references to all matter which is incapable of being classified under headings I or II. It will contain references to Reports on the meetings of the Circle, Obituary Notices, articles on the Sudan, Mackenzie-Low's "Index of Philatelic Literature Of Egypt", Byam's "Auction Prices" and "Market Jottings", Postal Information, etc.

"Auction Prices", "Market Jottings", "Auction Sales". No cross references

will be found under the class of material or issue of stamps commented on in these Notes as it is felt that such a procedure would make this List unduly cumbersome. The reference to each sale will, however, be found to contain a note of all the issues of stamps and classes of material commented on by Dr. Byam.

Members in charge of Studies will find much useful and helpful information in these Notes as little that comes under the hammer escapes the eagle eye of our chairman.

The foregoing remarks apply also to references under "Postal Information".

Pagination of the two volumes of "The Quarterly Circular".

It will be recalled that, in Volume I, pagination was by Issue, each number commencing with page 1, whereas Volume II was paginated as a complete volume.

As those members who have had their "Q.C.s" bound might find references under existing pagination somewhat difficult, more especially as it was not until the middle of the volume that the number of the issue was inserted at the head of every page, it is thought that they might like to re-paginate their first volume on the lines of Volume II and, for their guidance, the following table gives the old and suggested new pagination, both of which will be used in the present classified list.
